- 1) Officials of the League shall be an Honorary President who shall be the Mayor for the time being of the Metro- politan Borough of Barnsley, an Honorary Vice-President, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and two Match Secretaries.
- 2) Teams shall consist of three couples, i.e. Six males, six females or six mixed in any proportion. Twenty-one aces to constitute one game.
- 3) All matches to be decided on games won.
- 4) One point is to be allowed for a win.
- 5) All matches shall begin not later than 7.15 pm. Exceptions will be made where clubs, on Registration, state any other starting time, such time to be no earlier than 7 p.m. unless mutually agreed between competing teams.
- 6 a) Both teams shall have one couple on Court and ready to play at the prescribed time as determined in Rule 5. Should a team fail to conform to this rule their opponents may claim the first rubber (but not before 7 p.m.). Such claim can ONLY be implemented before the start of the match and should be marked as 'CLAIMED' on the match card. This rule shall apply to each sub-sequent rubber at fifteen minute intervals following the stated prescribed time.
- b) All unfinished matches (ie neither team has won five rubbers) shall be completed with the same players. The home team to arrange and provide court time as per rule 7(d), and to send a copy of the incomplete match card to the match secretary as per rule 12.
- 7 a) Matches to be played according to fixtures and only in exceptional circumstances may a match be cancelled - e.g. unavailability of Match Venue.

R U L E S

- b) Permission for any cancellation MUST be obtained from the League Match Secretary by the team requiring such a cancellation, and in default of compliance with this rule, the team requesting cancellation shall be fined £1.00.
 - c) If permission for cancellation is agreed the opponent team MUST be given as much notice as possible.
 - d) The home team must then within fourteen days offer, in writing, two open dates for the fixture to be played within the official season, and send a copy thereof to the League Match Secretary who MUST also be notified by the Home team of the date accepted.
 - e) Any team failing to accept one or other of the dates without adequate reason shall be fined £1.00 by the league and shall forfeit the match.
 - f) Any home team failing to offer two dates in accordance with sub-clause (d) above shall be fined £1.00 and shall forfeit the match.
 - g) If in the opinion of the League Match Secretary any conceded matches do, or may, affect promotion or relegation he shall have the authority to order that the conceded match be played.
 - h) Any team conceding a fixture (ie failing to field at least 2 pairings) shall be fined £5.00.
- 8 a) Equipment to be used in accordance with National Badminton Laws. In the case of dispute regarding the quality of the shuttles the visiting club can demand them to be produced at the next Committee meeting for a final decision. Carlton Tournament Nylon Shuttle-cocks should be used.
- b) Badminton Association of England rules shall apply in all games.
- 9) Clubs may have more than one team in the competition.
- 10) Players may elect their own scorer if one is desired.
- 11) Faults in respect of obstructions on roofs, lights or beams of Home Courts to be explained to visiting teams before games commence.

- 12) Full results of all matches shall be received by the Match Secretary not later than one week after the match, signed by both Captains. Failure to comply with this rule will result in a fine of £1.00 for the home team concerned.
- 13) Disputes shall be submitted to the Committee whose decision shall be final. The secretary of the club submitting the dispute to the League Committee shall inform in writing -
- a) the League Secretary
 - b) the secretary of the club with whom they are in dispute.
- Such notice to be given at least seven days before the next monthly Committee Meeting. Both sides to the dispute shall then be present at the Committee meeting to state their case. Should either or both the disputing sides not be present at the ensuing Committee meeting a decision may be reached in their absence.
- 14 a) When a club runs more than one team in the league, no 'B' team player can play more than twice for the 'A' team, otherwise he shall be classed as an 'A' team player. No 'A' team player may play in a 'B' team unless transferred to the 'B' team by a League Committee decision, and this rule shall be applied between a 'B' team and a 'C' team of any club. And provided also that when a 'C' team player plays more than a total of two games for a higher team or teams he will be registered as a member of the highest team for which he has played.
- b) When a player has been promoted to a higher team by virtue of playing more than two games for a higher team it shall not be possible during the current season to register such a player in a lower division.
 - c) No player re-registered in a lower team can play for a higher team during the remainder of that season. This will not apply to any player nominated under rule 16a if he has not actually played in the higher Division for which he was nominated and can show to the League Officers an acceptable reason for not so playing.

R U L E S

- d) If a player is re-registered from a higher team to a lower team a specific player must be named as a replacement if not already registered by way of qualification.
 - e) All transfer of players within a club or between clubs shall only be carried out at a monthly League Committee meeting unless rule 14a applies.
- 15) All new teams shall start in the lowest Division and shall be scrutinised by a sub-committee consisting of the League Officers and any two other members for entrance to the League.
- 16 a) Any club with more than one team in the league must nominate the players of their club for the teams in which they expect them to play to the League Match Secretary in writing, prior to the date of the first League fixture. Failure to do so will result in a £1.00 fine per match played and forfeiture of any match or matches won, until the rule is observed.
- b) Any registration of a player with any team following commencement of the fixtures to be automatic from the score card on which his name first appears unless stated to be a reserve - this to apply until the date of the January meeting. No new registrations or transfers will be accepted after that date, and the playing of a non-registered player after that date shall result in the club being fined £1.00.
 - c) In exceptional circumstances any club wishing to re-register any player in accordance with rule 14b must apply to the next monthly Committee meeting.
 - d) Any club with more than one team in the same division - these teams shall play each other as their first fixture.
 - e) If a player plays under the name of another player in a league match, then providing the case is proved to the satisfaction of the League meeting, the team members actually playing shall be banned from participating in any further League matches for that season. Additionally the offending club shall be fined £10.00 and the offending team be classed as a relegated team and all rubbers played shall be deducted for matches previously played.

- f) Any registration of a player not determined under the foregoing rules shall be registered in the lowest team of the club concerned unless otherwise directed.
- 17) Two teams shall be promoted from each lower division and two teams relegated from each higher division with the exception of division 3, where only one team shall be promoted to division 2 from each division 3. In the event of any teams finishing on equal points the issue, including the Division Championship, shall be determined on rubbers won. If the rubbers won are equal then the winner will be decided in a play-off on a neutral court. If any team withdraws from any division before completing its fixtures it shall be regarded as a relegation team for the purposes of this rule. Appropriate adjustments will be made throughout the lower divisions at the discretion of the Officers.
- 18) No player shall play for more than one team during the same evening.
- 19 a) The Annual Subscription to the League shall be agreed at each Annual General Meeting.
- b) All subscriptions shall be paid by 1st December each year. In the event of a non-payment the club concerned shall be fined £1.00 per team, and if not paid by the end of December, together with the fine, such team or teams shall not participate in the second half of the League programme and may not attend the League Meeting or join the League for the following season.
- c) All fines under these rules shall be paid by 31st May current season, except those referred to in subsection (b) of this rule for which specific requirements have been laid down. Failure to do this will result in such team or teams not being admitted to the League for the following season.
- 20) The League Committee shall consist of ONE representative from each club.

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- 21) Existing Rules can only be changed, or additional rules made, at the Annual General Meeting or an Extraordinary General Meeting.
- 22) That the six Officers of the League (Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and Match Secretaries) shall be ex-officio members of any sub-Committee appointed by the League.
- 23) All members of the League attending an Annual General Meeting are allowed to vote on any measure brought up at the meeting.
- 24) Any matters not already dealt with in these rules to be submitted to the Committee.
- 25) The League Secretary should receive 14 days notice of any matter to be placed on the Agenda for the Annual General Meeting.
- 26 a) Entrance fees for Barnsley League Tournaments to be sent to the Tournament Secretary along with the entries.
 - b) Tournament matches may only be played on the official court provided.
 - c) The Tournament Referee's decision to be final in all disputes.
- 27) A date when all fixtures must be complete shall be set at the start of the season.
- 28) Non-attendance at the Committee Meetings will result in a fine of £1.00.
- 29) Failure to return the Annual team enrolment form for membership of the League by the time stipulated by the League Committee shall result in a fine for the offending club of £1.00 per team.

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30) Mixed Division.

- a) If a club fails to attend the fixtures meeting and has made no previous arrangements for its season's fixtures with the Mixed Match Secretary, it shall not participate in that season's fixtures.
- b) On arranging fixtures each Club shall send a written list thereof to the Mixed Match Secretary.
- c) Registration of Players shall be made to the Mixed Match Secretary, otherwise the Registration rules for the main Divisions will apply.

31) Any trophies, whether for League or Tournament, shall be the responsibility of the relevant club, for both loss and damage, whilst in the possession of a club or club member.

32) League rules shall apply equally to all categories (ie main, mixed and ladies) with the exception of rule 2 with regard to team constitution in ladies and mixed leagues.

33) In the event of any dispute arising in the interpretation of these Rules the decision of the League Committee shall be final.

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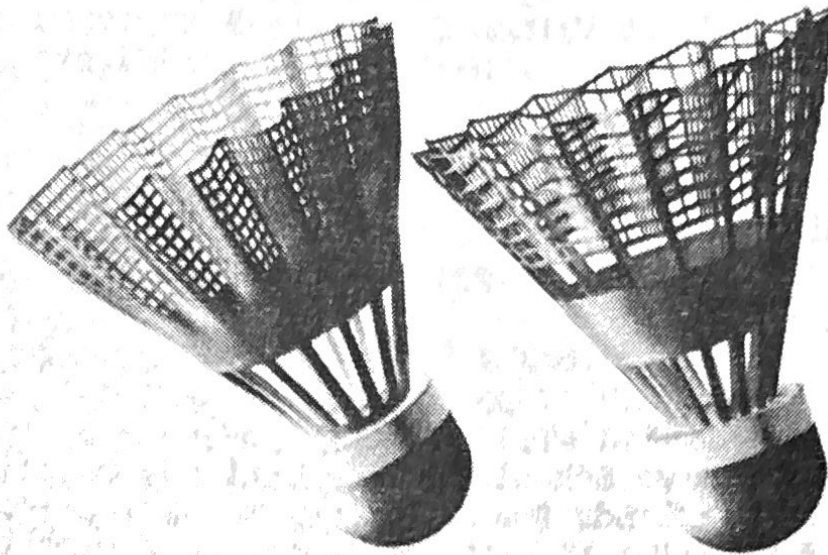
