RULES

- 1a) The **League Management Committee** shall consist of the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, all Match Secretaries and two other elected members. The day to day running and management of the League shall be handled by the Committee which will meet once a month throughout the season. The minutes of these meetings will be circulated to all club secretaries shortly afterwards.
 - 1b) Any League Management Committee quorum shall be six (of maximum nine).
 - 2) The Officers of the League (Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and Match Secretaries) shall be ex-officio members of any sub-committee appointed by the League.
 - 3) In addition to the AGM there shall be three general meetings each season at which **ALL** clubs must be represented. These meetings will be in September (to distribute handbooks and general information), January (closing date for registrations) and April (end of season). Non-attendance by any club at the AGM or any of the three general meetings will result in a fine of £5 per meeting.
 - 4) Existing rules can only be changed, or additional rules made, at the AGM or an Extra-Ordinary General Meeting.
 - 5) All members of the League attending an AGM are allowed to vote on any matter brought up at the meeting.
 - 6) The League Secretary should receive 28 days notice of any matter to be placed on the agenda for the AGM. This agenda and proposals to be circulated to clubs 14 days prior to the AGM.
 - 7) League rules shall apply equally to all categories (ie the main, mixed and ladies leagues) with the exception of rule 8 regarding mixed and ladies teams and specific rules for the mixed and ladies leagues.
 - 8) Teams shall consist of three couples, i.e. six males, six females or six mixed, in any proportion. No substitutes will be allowed.
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R U L E S

- 9) Badminton Association of England rules shall apply in all games.
 - 10) Equipment to be used in accordance with National Badminton laws. In the case of dispute regarding the quality of shuttles the visiting club can demand them to be produced at the next Committee meeting for a final decision. Carlton Tournament Nylon Shuttlecocks with Cork base, medium speed as marked on the blue hoop, should be used.
 - 11) Players may elect their own scorer if one is desired.
 - 12) Faults in respect of obstructions on roofs, lights or beams of home courts must be explained to the visiting team before games commence.
 - 13) Disputes shall be submitted to the Management Committee whose decision shall be final. The Secretary of the club submitting the dispute to the League Committee shall inform in writing both the League Secretary and the Secretary of the club with whom they are in dispute. Such notice must be given at least seven days before the next monthly meeting. Both sides to the dispute shall then be present at the meeting to state their case. Should either or both the disputing sides not be present at the ensuing meeting, a decision may be reached in their absence.
 - 14) Clubs may have more than one club in the Competition.
 - 15a) Any club with more than one team in the league must nominate the players of their club for the teams in which they expect them to play to the relevant Match Secretary, in writing, prior to the date of the first League fixture. Failure to do so will result in a £1 fine per match played and forfeiture of any points won, until the rule is observed.
 - 15b) Any registration of a player with any team following commencement of the fixtures to be automatic from the scorecard on which his name first appears unless stated to be a reserve - this to apply until the date of the January meeting. No new registrations will be accepted after that date, and the playing of a non-registered player after that date shall result in the club being fined £1.
 - 15c) When any club has more than one team in the same division, these teams shall play each other as their first fixture.
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RULES

- 15d) If a player plays under the name of another player in a league match, then providing the case is proved to the satisfaction of the League committee, the team members actually playing shall be banned from participating in any further league matches for that season. Additionally, the offending club shall be fined £10, the offending team be classed as a relegation team and all rubbers won shall be deducted for matches previously played.
 - 15e) Any registration of a player not determined under the foregoing rules shall be registered in the lowest team of the club concerned unless otherwise directed.
 - 16a) When a club runs more than one team in the league, no 'B' team player can play more than twice for the 'A' team, otherwise he shall be classed as an 'A' team player. No 'A' team player may play in a 'B' team unless transferred to the 'B' team by a League Committee decision, and this rule shall be applied between a 'B' team and a 'C' team (etc) of any club. Also, when a 'C' team player plays more than a total of two games for a higher team or teams he will be registered as a member of the highest team for which he has played.
 - 16b) When a player has been promoted to a higher team by virtue of playing more than two games for a higher team, it shall not be possible during the current season to re-register such a player in a lower division.
 - 16c) No player re-registered in a lower team can play for a higher team during the remainder of that season. This will not apply to any player nominated under rule 15a if he has not actually played in the higher division for which he was nominated, and can show to the League Officers an acceptable reason for not so playing.
 - 16d) If a player is re-registered from a higher team to a lower team a specific player must be named as a replacement if not already registered by way of qualification.
 - 16e) All transfer of players within a club or between clubs shall only be carried out at a monthly League Committee meeting unless rule 16a applies.
 - 16f) In exceptional circumstances any club wishing to re-register any player in accordance with rule 16d must apply to the next monthly League Committee meeting.
 - 17) No player shall play for more than one team during the same evening.
 - 18) A date when all fixtures for the main and mixed leagues must be completed shall be set at the start of the season.
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RULES

- 19a) Failure to return the club and team entry form for registration for the League by the date stipulated on the form shall result in a fine of £1 per team for the offending club.
 - 19b) Club and team entry forms submitted for entrance to the League each year shall not commit that club to any expense until verified at the first full meeting when handbooks are distributed.
 - 20) All clubs on registration must specify a match start time. This will be the time when both teams must have a couple on court ready to play. If either team does not have a pair ready to play at the stated match time, rubbers may be claimed immediately (but not before 7.00 even if a club has specified a 6.45 start). Such claim can only be implemented **before** the start of a match and should be marked as CLAIMED on the match card. This rule shall apply to each subsequent rubber at fifteen minute intervals following the stated match start time.
 - 21a) Matches to be played according to fixtures and only in exceptional circumstances may a match be cancelled - eg unavailability of match venue, or severe weather making travel impossible.
 - 21b) Where clubs find an unavoidable clash of **main league** fixture dates with matches in other leagues, they may rearrange the BDBL match subject to mutual agreement. Games due before Xmas can only be rearranged **before** 30 Sept, those after Xmas **before** 31 December. The new dates should fall in the same half of the season as the original match date.
 - 21c) Permission for any cancellation **MUST** be obtained from the League Match Secretary by the team requiring such a cancellation, and in default of compliance with the rule the team requesting cancellation shall be fined £1.
 - 21d) If permission for cancellation is agreed the opponent team **MUST** be given as much notice as possible.
 - 21e) The home team must then **within fourteen days** offer, in writing, two open dates for the fixture to be played within the official season, and send a copy thereof to the League Match Secretary who **MUST** also be notified by the home team of the date accepted.
 - 21f) Any home team failing to offer two dates in accordance with 21e shall be fined £1 and shall forfeit the match.
 - 21g) Any team failing to accept one or other of the dates without adequate reason shall be fined £1 and shall forfeit the match.
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RULES

- 21h) If, in the opinion of the League Match Secretary, any conceded matches do or may affect promotion or relegation he shall have the authority to order that the match be played.
 - 21i) Any team conceding a fixture (ie failing to field at least 2 pairings) shall be fined £5. Any team in any division that concedes three matches in one season to be treated as a relegation team. Any fixtures played by that team to be considered void.
 - 21j) Where any team fails to field 3 pairings on more than 2 occasions during the season, the offending team shall be fined £2 on each successive occasion, at the discretion of the committee.
 - 22a) Full results of all matches shall be received by the relevant Match Secretary not later than **one week** after the match, signed by both Captains. Failure to comply with this rule will result in a fine of £2 for the home team concerned.
 - 22b) All matches shall be decided on games won, 21 aces to constitute one game.
 - 22c) One point shall be awarded for each rubber won by a team in a match, with an additional two bonus points going to the winning team - e.g. in a 6-3 win, the winning team shall be awarded 8 points and the losers 3.
 - 23) All unfinished matches (ie neither team has won five rubbers) shall be completed **with the same players**. The home team shall arrange and provide court time as per rule 21d and send a copy of the incomplete match card to the Match Secretary as per rule 22a.
 - 24a) The annual subscription to the League shall be agreed at each A.G.M.
 - 24b) All subscriptions shall be paid by 1 December each year. In the event of a non-payment the club concerned shall be fined £1 per team, and if not paid by 31 December together with the fine, such team or teams shall not participate in the **second half of the League programme**, may not attend the League meetings or join the League for the following season.
 - 24c) All fines under these rules shall be paid by 31 May of the current season, except those referred to in 24b for which specific requirements have been laid down. Failure to do this will result in such team or teams not being admitted to the League for the following season.
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RULES

- 25) Two teams shall be promoted from each lower division and two teams relegated from each higher division with the exception of division 3, where only one team shall be promoted to division 2 from each division 3. In the event of any teams finishing on equal points the issue, including the Division Championship, shall be determined on matches won. If the matches won are equal then the winner will be decided in a play-off on a neutral court. If any team withdraws from any division before completing its fixtures it shall be regarded as a relegation team for the purposes of this rule. Appropriate adjustments will be made throughout the lower divisions at the discretion of the Officers.
- 26) All new teams applying to join the League will be scrutinised by the League Management Committee prior to inclusion.
- 27a) **MIXED LEAGUE ONLY.** If a club fails to attend the fixtures meeting and has made no previous arrangements for its season's fixtures with the Mixed Match Secretary, it shall not participate in that season's fixtures.
- 27b) On arranging fixtures each club shall send a written list thereof to the Mixed Match Secretary.
- 27c) Registration of players shall be made to the Mixed Match Secretary, but otherwise the Registration rules for the Main League will apply.
- 28a) **LADIES LEAGUE ONLY.** Registration of players shall be made to the Ladies Match Secretary, but otherwise the registration rules for the Main League will apply with the following exceptions :
- i) Clubs shall nominate their team members by the date of the April meeting
 - ii) No new registrations or transfers shall be allowed after the May meeting
 - iii) League subscriptions shall be paid by the April meeeting.
- 28b) Ladies matches may be re-arranged with the consent of both clubs and the Ladies Match Secretary, subject to at least 7 days notice.
- 29a) Entrance fees for the BDBL tournaments shall be sent to the Tournaments Secretray along with the entry forms.
- 29b) Tournament matches may only be played on the official court provided.
- 29c) The Tournament Referee's decision to be final in all disputes.
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RULES

- 30) Any trophies, whether for league or tournament, shall be the responsibility of the relevant club, for both loss and damage whilst in the possession of a club or club member.
- 31) In the event of any dispute arising in the interpretation of these rules, the decision of the League Committee shall be final.
- 32) All matters not already dealt with in these rules should be submitted to the League Committee.

NOTE : Under Badminton Association of England rules, net posts should be positioned on the sidelines of the doubles court. Where this is not possible, tapes (at least 40mm wide) should be placed over the net to indicate the position of the sidelines. Clubs who are unable to place posts on the sidelines are asked to conform to this ruling as a courtesy to their opponents.

FRIENDLY MATCHES

In order to try and give as many teams as possible a full program of 18 matches during the season, divisions 3, 4 and 5 have been set up such that the teams who do not have league matches in a particular week are able to play each other in 'friendly' fixtures. This means that the 'spare' team in 3E will play the 'spare' team in 3W each week, etc.

These matches will not be regarded as official fixtures, and so not count towards any league tables, pairs averages etc - nor do the rules regarding player registrations apply (for instance, playing as a reserve in these games will not count towards the two occasions on which players may play up - indeed players do not need to be registered to take part in these special games). Scorecards may be sent to the Match Secretary for information but are not necessary.

If either team is unable or unwilling to fulfil any of these fixtures, they must contact the opposition as early as possible. If matches cannot be played on the listed date, there is no compulsion to rearrange unless teams wish to do so.
